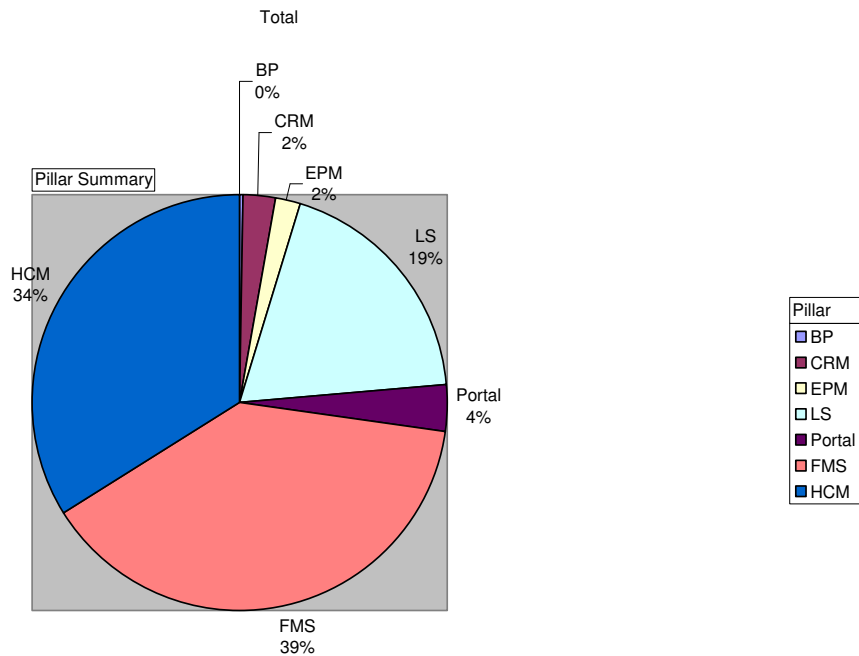


## Update on SQR Script Project

The original objective of the SQR Script Project was to analyze customer metadata contained in their PeopleSoft Enterprise database to gain insight on:

- Product (feature) usage and customization patterns
- Guidance on tech uptake for Apps - Prioritize BPEL implementation (high priority business processes 1st)
- SOA investment - Identify potential integration gaps
- Guidance around Business Intelligence (BI) and Usability investment - Highly used business activities (users to components)

**298** responses from **207** distinct PeopleSoft customers has been received to date. Here's the breakdown of the 298 responses by Enterprise product family:



The initial analysis by the Applications Development team provided benefits in the following areas:

- Valuable information about use of "Trees" that will enhance the centralized tree design in Fusion
- Good data regarding product feature usage and customizations that will assist in the prioritization of Fusion features, SOA investments for Application Integration, and BI investments.

Much of the data received was more technical in nature than originally expected. Additional research is planned by loading the data into Business Intelligence "cubes" for multi-dimensional analysis. This additional analysis has not been completed yet.
